The building will have limited or no access through Friday, March 27 to prevent what we have seen happening around the country and in our world due to the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). There will not be daycare from March 23 through March 27.

Our Board of Directors and administration believe we must act now to protect the health and wellbeing of our 370 students, 210 families, 50 employees and the community where we live.

We have had many conversations with local and state health officials, community leader. I know that closing our school will have a significant impact on our families, but we also believe that strong, urgent action must be taken to prevent the spread of this disease and to protect lives.

During the closure, we will continue with our cleaning efforts using effective disinfectants. We encourage you at home to continue hand washing and other **recommendations from the CDC** about how to avoid the spread of illness.
